## ORDINANCE NO. 35 CONTROLLING UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY Effective March 11, 1981

# SECTION 1.

The superintendent of Schools or designee, with proper authority, may order or cause the removal from school buildings or school property, of any individual who that person knows of has reason to believe:

- a. To be an individual who is <u>not a student</u> at the school and <u>has not been either invited</u> <u>to the school</u> by a proper authority or <u>have legitimate business</u> at the school or on the school property.
- b. <u>To have been expelled or suspended from school</u> provided that such expulsion or suspension is in full force and effect.
- c. <u>To be indulged in any criminal activity</u> in or on school property, or to conspire to indulge in such activity.
- d. <u>To be a person who is instigating</u> or may instigate, by any means whatever, <u>a</u> <u>disturbance</u> of any sort on the school property.

#### **SECTION 2.**

No person shall damage, deface or destroy any public school building or any building occupied by any public school or the grounds, outbuildings, fences, trees or other appurtenances, fixtures or personal property belonging thereto.

#### **SECTION 3.**

- a. No person shall operate a motor vehicle upon any property owned by the Oscoda Public Schools or occupied by the Oscoda Public Schools unless an employee of the Oscoda Public Schools or unless such person is presently enrolled in said school and not subject to suspension or exclusion therefrom, or is transporting students to or from school property during regular hours to school opening and school closing, or is attending an authorized and properly supervised activity and such person shall so operate a motor vehicle upon streets and roadways designated for vehicular traffic.
- b. No person shall operate any unlicensed motor vehicle upon any property owned or occupied by the Oscoda public Schools.

#### **SECTION 4.**

Any person found to be in violation of the foregoing Sections shall, upon direction from the Superintendent of Schools, or any person authorized, leave the school building or school property.

## SECTION 5.

VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF SHALL BE A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY FINE OF NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS AND/OR INPRISONMENT IN THE COUNTY JAIL FOR NOT MORE THAN NINETY (90) DAYS.

This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after publication thereof.
