ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE TO DEFINE, CONTROL AND PROHIBIT THE LITTERING OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY AND WATERS, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Effective: April 1, 1981

THE TOWNSHIP OF AU SABLE ORDAINS:

- 1. The term "litter" as used herein means all rubbish, refuse, waste material, garbage, offal, paper, glass, cans, bottles, trash debris or other foreign substances of every kind and description.
- 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, in person or by his or its agent, employee or servant, to dump, deposit, place, throw or leave, or cause to permit the dumping, depositing, placing or throwing or leaving of, litter on any public or private property or waters unless the same be a publicly designated landfill facility. "Waters" includes but is not limited to any body of water or water course or the shores or beaches thereof and including the ice above such waters.
- 3. It shall be unlawful for any owner, tenant, person, firm or corporation to permit, maintain, or allow litter on the property or premises owner or occupied by such person, firm or corporation unless the litter is in a receptacle designated for that purpose.
- 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of the Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00 and or imprisoned in the County Jail for not more than 90 days for each offense; a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
