- B) Ordinance #134 This ordinance is being introduced for the public hearing. Ordinance #134 will amend any home storage as a home occupation to be prohibited. This amendment will be located in Section 7.03 Home Occupations & Home Based Business Item C. Prohibited Uses and Activities, and #4 Rental of space for storage.
 Romero made the motion to recommend adoption by the Township Board. Second by London Unanimous Roll Call Vote

- C) Ordinance #135 This ordinance is also for introduction to the public. The purpose of the amendment is to is to regulate the parking of recreational vehicles on vacant lots. The change shall be located under Section 3.15 Recreational Vehicles Storage, Item D. No recreational vehicles shall be stored on a vacant lot without a principal structure. A recreational vehicle may be stored on a vacant lot which is adjacent to a lot with a principal structure if both lots are under same ownership. Also included will be amended in this Ordinance #135, under Section 3.16 Recreational Equipment & Utility Trailor Storage, Item C.

No recreational equipment or utility trailer shall be stored on a vacant lot which is adjacent to a lot without a principal structure if both lots are under the same ownership. London made the motion to put forth Ordinance #135 to the township board for approval. Second by Romero Unanimous – Roll Call Vote Motion Carried
